Oversight also covers SUD clinical assessments for probationers and parolees through social service clinicians in Probation & Parole districts.

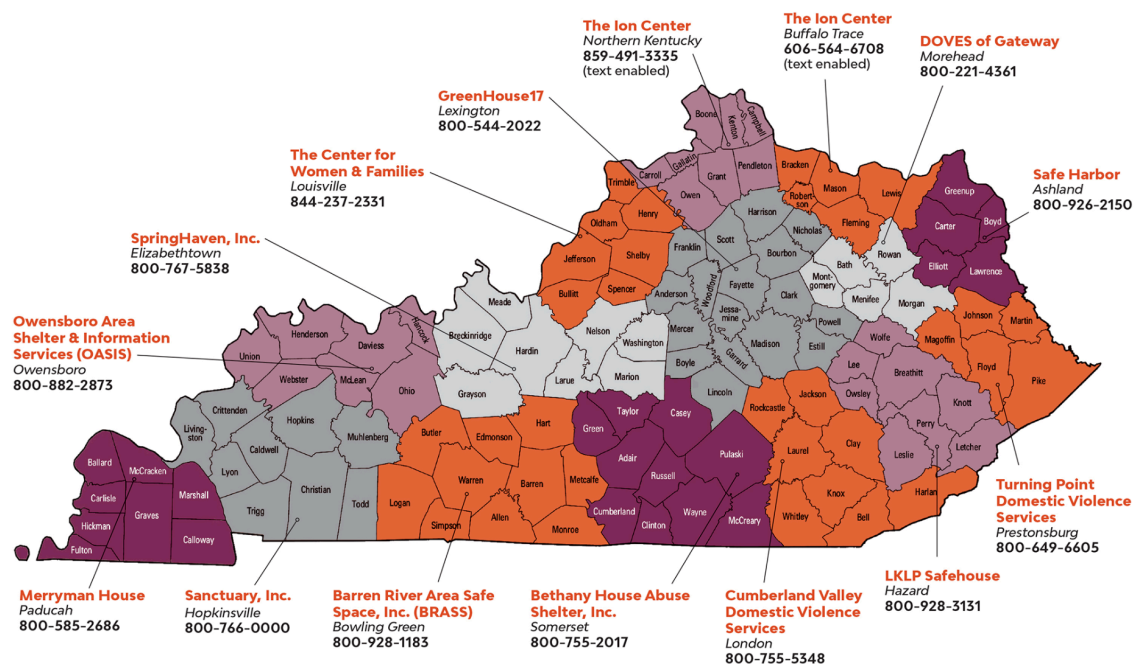
